GARY KEYS'S film is an affectionate and intimate memoir of DUKE ELLINGTON, as remembered by two of his most loyal sidemen, trumpeter COOTIE WILLIAMS and saxophonist RUSSELL PROCOPE. Interspersed with their recollections of what it was like to serve under the finest of American bandleaders, the film presents a valuable live performance by the last great edition of the ELLINGTON Orchestra, the 1968 group, captured in Mexico City. The live set includes a number of ELLINGTON chestnuts as well as an otherwise unrecorded piece, the 'Mexican Suite', and many of the most distinguished ELLINGTONIANS are present - including the incomparable sax section of HARRY CARNEY, JOHNNY HODGES, PAUL GONSALVES and RUSSELL PROCOPE himself. The interviews offer a moving memento of two masters: RUSSELL PROCOPE died shortly after the film was completed, and COOTIE WILLIAMS passed away in 1985. The music lives on.

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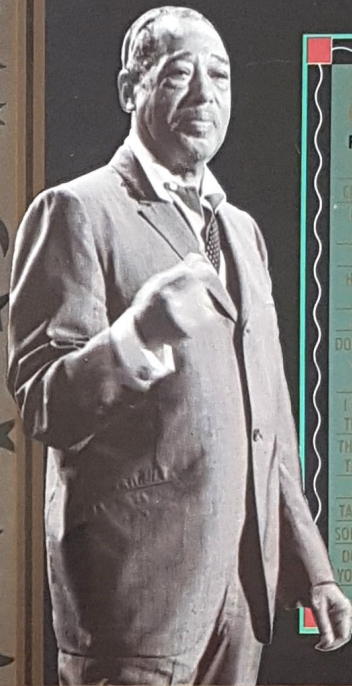
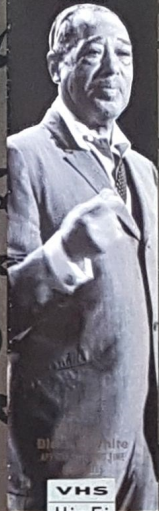

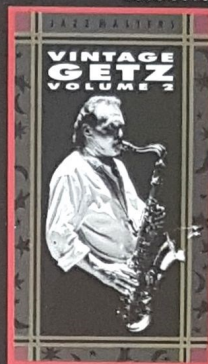
