## A DOCUMENTARY TV'S FIRST MUSIC VIDEOS THE SNADER TELESCRIPTIONS

Almost since the beginning of television, there were music videos. They don't look the same as today's rock videos, but they have their own special charm. These three minute musical films were called SNADER TELESCRIPTIONS and were made between

Shot live, with three cameras, these music videos of the 50's featured some of the biggest stars of the era. DUKE ELLINGTON, PEGGY LEE, COUNT BASIE. MEL TORMÉ, CHARLIE BARNET, CAB CALLOWAY, NAT "KING" COLE, TERESA BREWER, SARAH VAUGHAN and dozens of other artists appeared in them.

TV's FIRST MUSIC VIDEOS is an overview of this special part of television history. In addition to

generous samplings of the diverse musical talents who appeared in SNADERS, we also feature DUKE GOLDSTONE, producer/director/editor of over 700 of these films. To host the show, we have internationally known night club owner, music publisher, record producer and Di. GENE NORMAN, who originally introduced the SNADERS to TV audience

This is the first documentary on this nearly forgotten part of early television. Along with the superb musicians listed above, we also present some of the fascinating curiosities of the era - acrobats. trained dog acts and a wide array of musical styles like classical, folk, Hawaiian and country music.

The program presents a panorama of the various great artists of the time. It has a special appeal to those who grew up with the music, but should appeal to anyone with a taste for fine music and
